Historical/Biographical Note:

Members of the McCutcheon/McCutchan/McCutchen family were among the earliest settlers in Augusta County and had land on the original Beverley Manor tract. Scope & Content:

Consists of one 43-page manuscript, which describes the descendants of John McCutcheon (1750-1832) and Elizabeth Hodge (1700s). There are short histories of family members. Major emphasis is placed on the following two families: William Thomas McCutchan (1851-1927) and Mary Young Trimble (1851-1931) of Virginia and Missouri; Thomas Travis Trimble (1869-1949) and Martha Lee Travis (1868-1934) of Missouri and Louisiana.
